Friday, Oct. 7 – Homecoming Parade and RedStepper Dinner Details

Please note the parking for Alumni Band Parade participants and RedSteppers will be in the grass lots behind the DeVault Center. With the parade staging, your best access will be to take Indiana Avenue south to 13th Street. Turn left and you will come to a number of parking options along Forrest Avenue. RedSteppers would do well to arrive early to avoid any traffic mishaps.

The full parade route begins at Woodlawn and 17th Street, in front of Memorial Stadium, continues south on Woodlawn Avenue. The parade turns left at 13th Street, left on Fee, and left again on 17th Street to end where we started. The Marching Hundred Alumni Band will play on the steps of Marching Hundred Hall for from 5:00 to 5:30 pm, providing entertainment the IUAA VIP Tent before the parade begins. Once the parade begins the Alumni Band will meld into the Marching Hundred, which will be the last entry in the parade.

Parade dress code is your favorite IU spirit wear. Alumni who are not marching in the parade, and their guests, may gather to watch the parade at 17th Street and Woodlawn where there will be food trucks. Feel free to bring your own stadium chairs or blankets. Please note entrance to the IUAA Tent is by IUAA invitation only.

Flag Corps: Please wear the Alumni Flag Corps grey crewneck sweatshirt, grey long sleeve t-shirt, red polo, red jacket, and/or black puffer vest along with black bottoms and black shoes.

We will have hats and a limited amount of band apparel available for purchase at the registration table Saturday morning. The online apparel store will re-open after Homecoming.

Legacy Guests

Since they will not be marching into Memorial Stadium, Legacy participants will need a ticket to enter. You may obtain your complimentary ticket at the morning registration table.

Borrowed Instruments

Those who requested an instrument by September 23 can pick up theirs up at Marching Hundred Hall, 4:00 pm on Friday and 6:00 am on Saturday. If you did not request an instrument in time, the Band Department is unable to fulfill any more requests. If you need a sousaphone, baritone, mellophone, or percussion instrument, we suggest checking with your local high school for instrument availability.

We will be serving a box lunch and beverages to the Marching Hundred Alumni Band at Marching Hundred Hall beginning at 10 a.m.

Game Day Security

IU Athletics has implemented <u>a clear bag and metal detector policy</u> for all home games at Memorial Stadium and Assembly Hall. All Marching Hundred Alumni and their guests should be prepared with approved bags and allow extra time for security screening upon entering the Stadium.

Parking for the Parade – Friday, Oct. 7

The parking for Alumni Band Parade participants and RedStepper Reunion Dinner will be in the grass Lot C and Lot F behind the DeVault Center and Marching Hundred Hall. Both are accessible off Forrest Avenue and will best be approached from Indiana Avenue and 13th Street. Please note that Hoosier Hysteria is scheduled for 8:00 pm in Assembly Hall. Parking restrictions will apply and traffic will be heavier than usual.

Parking for Homecoming Day - Saturday, Oct. 8

Please carpool where possible! New Saturday Parking location this year. The first 130 cars will park in the Briscoe Lot, located on the Southeast corner of 17th and Fee. \$5 Cash at the gate. Overflow cars will be directed to the Forrest Avenue Parking Garage, located at 1015 E. 11th Street just east of Woodlawn. \$5.00 at gate. The Briscoe Lot is closer than last year's parking lot and the Forrest Avenue Parking Garage is a bit further. We hope this change eases the morning gridlock.
